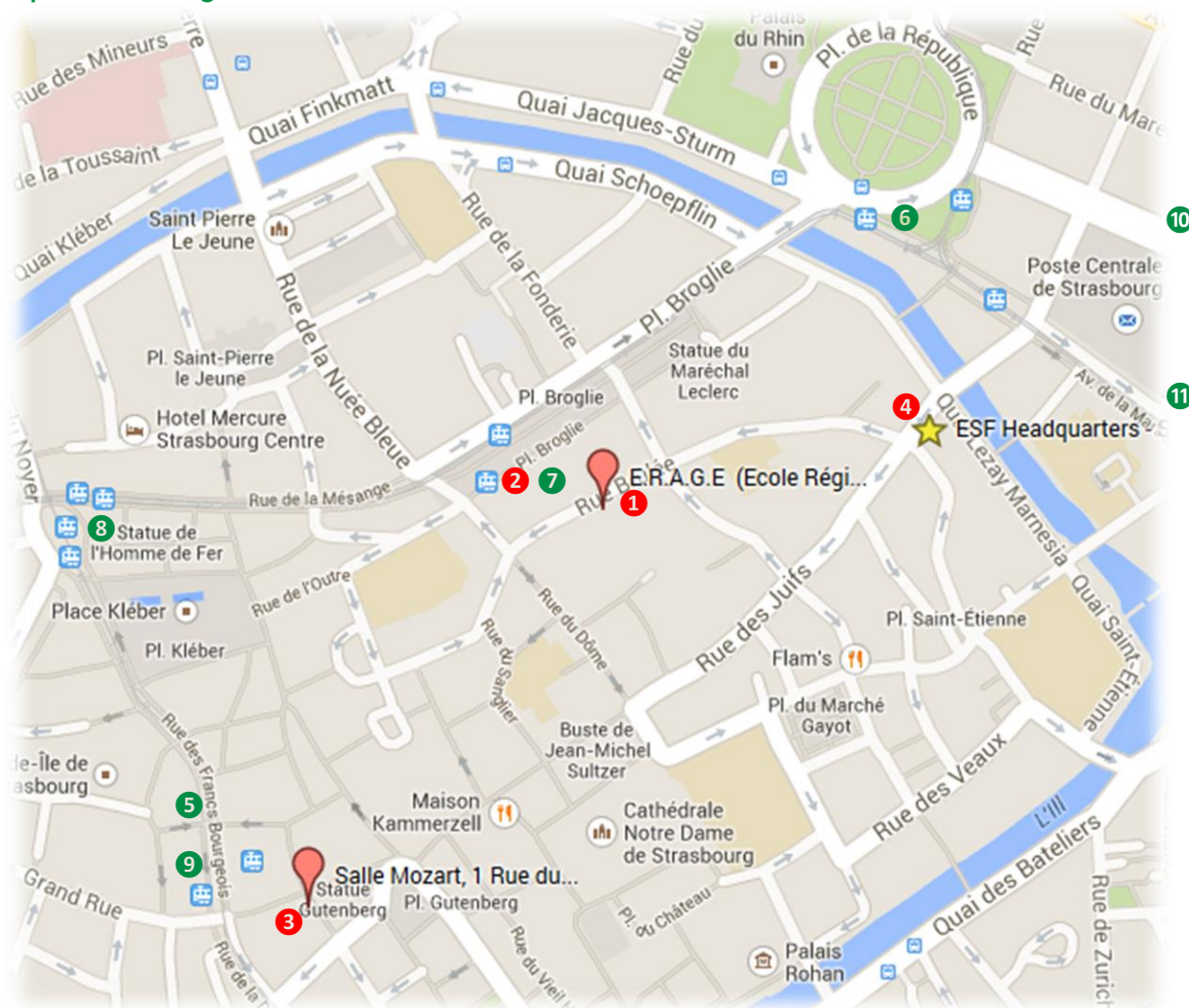

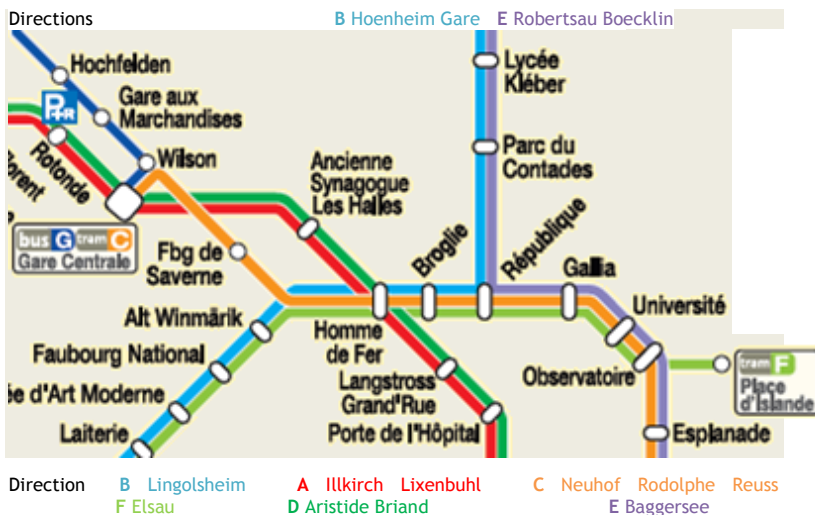

## TRAVELLING TO STRASBOURG

FLIGHTS	<p><b>Strasbourg Entzheim</b> SXB  <a href="http://www.strasbourg.aeroport.fr">www.strasbourg.aeroport.fr</a></p>	<p>Take the <b>shuttle train</b> to Strasbourg central station. It departs up to 4 times an hour, and takes only 9 minutes. A ticket costs c. 4€ and will allow you to connect to the bus and tram lines during 90 minutes following validation. From the station you can walk or take the tram (see directions below).                  A <b>taxi</b> will take 20-25 minutes and cost is about 35€ from the airport into the centre of Strasbourg (an evening/night fare will be more expensive).</p>
	<p><b>Karlsruhe-Baden</b> FKB  <a href="http://www.badenairpark.de">www.badenairpark.de</a></p>	<p>Baden airport is around 40km from Strasbourg.                  There are <b>shuttle services</b> to Strasbourg (e.g. <a href="http://alsace-navette.com">http://alsace-navette.com</a> taking about an hour; prices from c. 20€ single).                  A <b>taxi</b> will cost approximately 80€.</p>
	<p><b>Basel-Mulhouse</b> BSL  <a href="http://www.euroairport.com">www.euroairport.com</a></p>	<p>The best way from the airport to Strasbourg, which is c. 130 km distance, is to take the regular shuttle bus to Saint Louis train station (10 mins, 2€) then train to Strasbourg (c. 1 hour).</p>
	<p><b>Frankfurt</b> FRA  <a href="http://www.frankfurt-airport.com">www.frankfurt-airport.com</a></p>	<p>There is a <b>Lufthansa shuttle bus</b>, travel time approx. 2.5 hours, which stops at Strasbourg train station and outside the Hilton Hotel. The bus ticket can be bought separately, or as part of your flight.                  There are also connections via <b>train</b> - click <a href="#">here</a> for the German railway website - travel time just over 2 hours.</p>
TRAIN	<p><a href="http://www.sncf.fr">www.sncf.fr</a></p>	<p>Strasbourg train station is situated close to the town centre, with connections from major French towns, Belgium, Germany and Switzerland. The TGV (high-speed) train connects Strasbourg to <b>Paris Gare de l'Est</b> and also from <b>Paris Charles de Gaulle</b> airport.</p>

## TRAVELLING IN STRASBOURG

If you have taken the shuttle train from the airport, the tram journey is included in the ticket. As a general guideline, a single ticket costs c. 1.60€ and a ticket for 24-hour unlimited travel c. 4.10€.

### NEAREST STOPS

From the station, take tram **Line C** (direction Neuhof Rodolphe Reuss) to:

- **Place Broglie** for the **event** (E.R.A.G.E, portrait exhibition & reception)
- **Place de la République** for the **ESF**
- The nearest station to **Salle Mozart (dinner)** is Langstross Grand'Rue (tram line A or D; change at Place de l'Homme de Fer)

**Hotel Maison Rouge**  
 Langstross Grand'Rue (tram line A or D)

**Hotel Régent Contades**  
 Gallia (tram line C, E & F)
